Defendants and counsel to appear in-person, unless waiver/motion filed and approved for:

Arraignments, including VOPs, Rule
Pretrial Conferences
Motions: Unless agreement otherwise 14 days prior to hearing
Jury Draws and Jury Trials
VOP Merits and Sentencing
Change of Plea, Sentencing
Attorney or Appear Hearings
Competency

For all in-person hearings: unless a waiver of appearance has been filed and granted or a motion to appear remotely has been filed and granted, parties (Counsel and Defendants) are all expected to be present in person.

Defendants and counsel may participate remotely for:

Status Conference, VOP Status Conferences
Lodged Rule 5 Arraignments

For all the above remote hearing types: Unless you know/expect to have a change of plea, parties are not required to appear in-person.

If a hearing is available as a remote hearing, you may appear in person if you wish to.

Exhibits should be filed at least seven (7) days prior to hearing through Odyssey File and Serve or the Evidence Portal consistent with statewide protocols.
