JUVENILE PROBATION CERTIFICATE

You have been found by the Juvenile Court to have committed the following delinquent act(s):

At a hearing held on _____, the judge placed you on juvenile probation. The court orders that you follow these conditions while you are on probation:

- A. Follow the rules of your home or living situation.
- B. Use good behavior in the community, at home and in school. Commit no criminal or delinquent acts.
- C. Do not change your address or place of residence without approval from your parent/guardian and your juvenile probation officer.
- D. Participate fully in any program (including but not limited to substance screening, assessment and/or treatment) to which your juvenile probation officer refers you.
- E. Stay within the State of Vermont unless your parent/guardian and your juvenile probation officer give you permission to leave.
- F. Cooperate with, and report to, your juvenile probation officer as directed. Allow your juvenile probation officer to visit you at home or elsewhere.
- G. Be drug and alcohol free. Do not buy, possess or use alcohol or illegal drugs. Do not purchase, possess, use, give, or sell cigarettes or other tobacco products.
- H. If you are enrolled in school or a training program, attend daily and on time, unless excused. Attend all classes, complete your work to the best of your ability, and follow all rules. If you are employed, comply with all employment duties. If your work schedule or job changes, you must tell your juvenile probation officer.

In addition to the standard conditions, the Court orders these additional conditions:

- 1. You shall appear before the Juvenile Restorative Panel and actively participate and complete all of the conditions set by the Panel. In order to participate in the panel process you will be asked to sign an agreement to waive your rights to confidentiality. This waiver will pertain to your participation in the panel process only. Members of the Panel will also sign an agreement that restricts any discussion of your case to their participation in the panel process. The Panel shall not order financial restitution of more than \$ _____.

9. At the request of your juvenile probation officer, you shall submit to a drug and/or alcohol assessment and follow recommendations. If your probation officer asks you to, you must agree to urine and/or breath tests for drugs or alcohol. The results of those tests may be shared with the court.
