CLOSURE REPORT OF THE VERMONT JUDICIAL CONDUCT BOARD

Re: Docket No.: 17.006

This Complaint is the result of a series of lengthy proceedings involving real estate where the trial court awarded title to the property to the opposing parties. This decision was affirmed by the Vermont Supreme Court. Another lawsuit was commenced by Complainant, and the opposing parties prevailed again. This decision was also affirmed by the Vermont Supreme Court. Complainant raises the same legal arguments in this Complaint that were rejected by the Vermont Supreme Court.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry, including review of the filings by Complainant and a review of the underlying cases. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

Accordingly, the Complaint in Docket No. 17.006 is DISMISSED.
