You have been found by the Court to have committed the following delinquent act(s):

At a hearing held on _____, the Judge placed you on probation. Failure to comply with the conditions of your probation certificate may result in a graduated sanction, a violation of probation filing, placement at a secure juvenile facility, or incarceration. A finding that you have violated your probation could result in additional probation conditions, an extension of the term of probation, a change in custody, or placement at a secure facility. If you commit a new offense and are adjudicated or convicted while on probation, that may constitute a violation. The Court orders that you follow these additional conditions while you are on probation:

- ☐ 1. You shall actively participate in a restorative process and complete all conditions set forth. Members that participate in the process will sign an agreement that restricts any discussion of your case to their participation in the panel process. In order to participate in the process, you will have to tell the members about the facts of your offense and take responsibility.
- ☐ 2. Engage in a service-learning project, community service or opportunity to repair the harm with victim or community as determined by your Probation Officer or BARJ.
- ☐ 3. For the duration of your probation, do not associate with the following individuals without prior approval of your probation officer: _____
- ☐ 4. You shall not harass, nor cause anyone else to harass, the following: _____
- ☐ 5. Do not go to the following place: _____, unless approved by your Probation Officer.
- ☐ 6. Be home at _____, or with your parent/guardian or other adult approved by the Court or probation officer during the following hours: _____ to _____, unless modified by your probation officer.

- ☐ 7. Do not have any weapons or other destructive devices on you or accessible to you at your home, including (but not limited to) firearms, ammunition, explosives, and bows.
- ☐ 8. When your probation officer reasonably suspects that you have been using drugs or alcohol, your probation officer may require you to submit to a urine and/or breath test for drugs or alcohol.
- ☐ 9. You shall successfully complete a treatment program at_____.
- ☐ 10. Be drug and alcohol free. Do not buy, possess, or use alcohol, marijuana, illegal drugs, or any regulated drugs unless they are prescribed to you by a medical provider.
- ☐ 11. Faithfully attend school or training at_____.
- ☐ 12. Work faithfully at_____or seek employment.
- ☐ 13. Remain within the State of Vermont unless granted permission to leave by your probation officer.

- ☐ 15. You shall submit to a drug or alcohol assessment and follow recommendations for treatment.
- ☐ 16. Notify your probation officer within 24 hours of any change of address or place of residence.
- ☐ 17. Report to your juvenile probation officer as directed. Answer all reasonable inquiries by your juvenile probation officer.
- ☐ 18. Allow your juvenile probation officer to visit you at reasonable times at home or elsewhere.
- ☐ 19. Sign appropriate releases of information to allow your probation officer to monitor the compliance with your probation conditions.
- ☐ 20 **For Youthful Offender Only:** Participate in electronic monitoring as directed by your probation officer and abide by all electronic monitoring, user agreements, controls and conditions as directed.

- ☐ 22. You shall successfully enroll, participate in, and complete a program/treatment for sex offenders as directed by your probation officer or designee.

(Including letters, phone calls, tapes, visits, videos, electronically or any form of contact through a third party) unless approved and documented in advance by your probation officer.
- ☐ 24. You may not purchase, possess, or use pornography or erotica. You may not go to adult bookstores, sex shops, topless bars.
- ☐ 25. You may not own, possess or use a camera, recorder, cell phone, or other electronic device that has recording capabilities, without prior permission of your probation officer or designee. If permission is granted you must enable your probation officer to access these devices to monitor compliance with probation conditions.
- ☐ 26. You may not access or loiter in places where children congregate, e.g., parks, playgrounds, schools, etc., unless otherwise approved and documented in advance by your probation officer.

- ☐ 27. Your probation officer may place restrictions on your interactions with certain groups of people. You shall inform your probation officer of the following relationships/social connections:
- ☐ A dating relationship that involves or will likely involve intimate or sexual acts.
 - ☐ A social or dating relationship with any person who has children underage.

I also understand that if I do not comply with any of the above conditions, if I am found by a judge to be delinquent in the future, or if I am later convicted of an adult crime, the Court may find me in violation of probation. I understand that the Court can then give me more conditions to complete and take other appropriate action, such as revocation of probation. 33 V.S.A §5263(b).
