**NOTICE PURSUANT TO RULES OF SUPREME COURT  
DISCIPLINARY CONTROL OF JUDGES, RULE 9(5)**

On October 21, 2021, the Board entered a Discovery/Stipulation and Order that called for discovery to be complete and the case ready for trial by April 15, 2022. The estimated length of trial was one (1) day.

Pursuant to Rule 9(5), the Board hereby gives notice that the time and place for the hearing shall be **August 19, 2022 beginning at 9:00 AM** and the duration of the hearing shall be one (1) day. The hearing will take place at the Chittenden Superior Court. Attendance shall be in-person or by Webex. The hearing shall be conducted before the entire Board. The Hon. Mary Miles Teachout shall serve as the presiding officer.

Pursuant to Rule 9(7) the parties are reminded that “[t]he hearing shall conform to the rules of procedure and evidence governing the trial of civil actions. Special counsel or disciplinary counsel shall be designated by the Board to present the evidence in support of the Formal Complaint. **The failure of the judge to appear in person or by counsel may be treated as a waiver of all defenses and a concession of the violation.**”

On or before **July 19, 2022**, the parties shall (1) notify the Board whether they (and any witnesses) intend to participate in-person or by Webex and (2) file any pretrial motions including motions in limine.

On or before **August 12, 2022** the parties shall file, via email to [bblackman@lynnlawvt.com](mailto:bblackman@lynnlawvt.com) and [lcw@rsclaw.com](mailto:lcw@rsclaw.com), all exhibits for use at the hearing.
