In the above-entitled cause, the Clerk will enter:

Respondent, Jacob O. Durell, is a lawyer licensed to practice law in the State of Vermont. Disciplinary Counsel and respondent have filed a stipulation to transfer respondent to disability inactive status due to a medical condition that currently incapacitates respondent from practicing law. Based on the parties' stipulation and this Court's review of the accompanying evidence, the Court concludes that respondent is currently incapacitated from continuing to practice law. We therefore order that:

- (1) Respondent shall be transferred to disability inactive status in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 21(C).
- (2) The Court appoints James Swift, Esq., as Trustee in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 24. Attorney Swift shall take action as seems indicated to protect the interests of respondent and respondent's clients, including compliance with the requirements of Administrative Order 9, Rule 23.
- (3) In the event that respondent petitions for reinstatement from disability inactive status in accordance with Administrative Order 9, Rule 21(E) and the petition is denied, the one-year waiting period set forth under Administrative Order 9, Rule 22(C) shall not apply and he shall be permitted to reapply at six-month intervals.
