Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 13.008

This Complaint arises from Complainant's unhappiness with two Judges' Decisions and Rulings. Complainant was relieved of duties by his employer after an investigation of purportedly stolen drugs. Complainant then filed a civil lawsuit against the employer which is still pending. Concurrently, Complainant was facing professional licensing issues, which apparently are also still pending. Complainant believes that both judges involved at an appellate level in his two cases made erroneous legal and evidentiary decisions, and claims violations of Canon 3. Both Judges held hearings and issued written decisions.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry including a review of the many pleadings and orders filed by the parties in the Court. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 13.008 is DISMISSED.
