Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 13.038

Complainant is unhappy with the prosecutor, his attorney, the judicial system in general and the Judge. He alleges the Judge was unfaithful to the law and failed to avoid impropriety which, if founded, could potentially be violations of Canon 2 and 3. Complainant is incarcerated on a pending violation of probation charge. He alleges his incarceration is past his sentence maximum. The Judge has not committed an ethical violation simply because Complainant remained incarcerated based on a pending charge.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.
