## Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

This Complaint is the result of eviction matter brought *pro se* by a Limited Liability Company's owner. Complainant's motion to pay rent into court was denied due to Complainant's failure to file the required documents legally required to pursue successfully his claims. However, Complainant was given 60 days to cure and failed to do so. Complainant makes no ethical allegations. In dismissing the complaint the Judge suggested that the Complainant retain counsel to insure that any future filings complied with the procedural rules.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry.
