Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Complainant raises speedy trial issues in his complaint. He also claims that the number of his prior convictions has been miscalculated and seeks legal advice from the Judicial Conduct Board. The Complaint fails to identify the unethical conduct and mentions only one judge who had at most a peripheral involvement in the underlying case. Complainant was given thirty days to supplement the filing with some specific allegations but failed to do so.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 14.042 is DISMISSED.
