## Closure Report of the Vermont Judicial Conduct Board

Re: Docket No. 14.044

This Complaint is the result of a post divorce action dealing with the enforceability of a prenuptial agreement. Complainant makes numerous allegations, most of which are variations on a theme that the substantive ruling was erroneous. These are legal findings and are appealable. The final complaint asserts that the Judge's Decision is rife with mistakes, such as in stating the exact ages of the children. Even if true, there is no allegation that these "mistakes" somehow affected the Decision.

The Judicial Conduct Board conducted an initial inquiry. To the extent the Complaint alleges ethical impropriety or a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Board has determined that the Complaint is unfounded and there is no cause for further proceedings. *Rules of the Supreme Court for the Disciplinary Control of Judges*, Rule 11.

The Complaint in Docket No. 14.044 is DISMISSED.
